Enclosed are the 2012 season pass rates and a season pass application. As offered in the past, these are season passes and not equity memberships, therefore no stock purchase is required and you are not subject to assessment. Please note that each season pass purchase must be accompanied by a fully completed and signed **Season Pass Application**.

Included with your purchase of a season pass are the following items:

1. Wisconsin River Golf Club Bag Tag
2. One free guest pass (9 or 18 holes) \*
3. A \$25 gift certificate good on range balls, lessons, food, beverages or cart rental \*
4. Entry into the Club Championship tournament and member dinner \*

\* With a couple pass or family pass, you will receive 2 of each of these items

For new pass holders, your purchase of a 2012 season pass becomes effective upon payment and the remainder of the 2011 golf season is yours to begin play. The golf course will remain open this fall until it is no longer playable. We will have regular pro shop hours through December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2011.

Punch cards and discount cards will continue to be offered as alternatives to the listed pass options. These rates and regular green fees are available through fliers at the WRGC pro shop and are listed on our website [www.golftheriver.com](http://www.golftheriver.com).

Both banquet rooms will be available for holiday or other off season parties through December 31<sup>st</sup> 2011. Friday night fish fry continues but will close for the season on November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

Finally, we encourage you to contact us to book dates for any golf outings that you run. Outings held in 2011 and rebooked for 2012 will have date priority up until January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012.
